Pursuant to Article IV (4) a) of the Constitution of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Parliamentary Assembly of Bosnia and Herzegovina, in the session of the House of Representatives, held on 20 November 2003 and in the session of the House of Peoples, held on 28 January 2004, adopted the following

LAW ON AMENDMENTS OF THE LAW ON STATE SERVICE IN THE INSTITUTIONS OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA

Article 1

In the Law on State Service in the Institutions of Bosnia and Herzegovina (“Official Gazette of BiH” No. 12/02 and 19/02) – hereinafter referred to as: the Law, in Article 4 the words “the Ombudsmen of Bosnia and Herzegovina” shall be added after the words “hereinafter referred to as: the Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina”.

Article 2

In Article 6 of the Law after subparagraph 3 a new subparagraph 4 shall be added to read as follows: "This Law shall not be applied to persons employed at the Office of the Human Right Ombudsmen of Bosnia and Herzegovina."

Article 3

This Law shall enter into force on the eighth day from its publication in the Official Gazette of BiH."
